OVERVIEW / ENVIRONMENT

IDE Hard Drives larger than 137 GB are not recognized under any Windows OS. The symptom that accompanies this issue is the operating system not completing the boot process.

RESOLUTION

Microsoft Operating systems have a 137 GB limit for IDE Hard Drives. Intel has created a workaround with their Intel Application Accelerator, version 2.3 or later. To resolve the issue, install the Intel Application Accelerator, version 2.3 or later.
