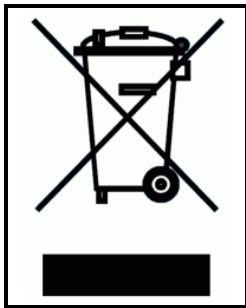
## WEEE Information for ClearCube Customers

### Background

ClearCube Technology is committed to meeting the obligations of the European Union Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) directive. The goal of the directive is to reduce the environmental impact due to the disposal of electrical and electronic equipment that has reached the end of its useful service life. This directive was initiated on August 13, 2005. ClearCube's approach to fulfilling these requirements is outlined below.

### Product Design

ClearCube manufacturing and engineering guidelines ensure that the recycling and recovery of electrical and electronic components is taken into account in all product designs.



### Product Labeling

All ClearCube branded products manufactured after August 13, 2005 are compliant with the WEEE directive marking requirements. These products are easily identified by the “crossed out wheeled bin” symbol (shown to the left) displayed on their labels.

### Customer Recycling Information

ClearCube products are sold exclusively to commercial and industrial customers and not to private households. Under the WEEE legislation terms, commercial and industrial customers have the responsibility to ensure that all electrical and electronic equipment is disposed of properly and in accordance with all applicable laws and local regulations. To assist this effort, ClearCube is developing guidelines and providing information to help our customers understand and meet the requirements of the WEEE directive.
